We are fast approaching National Police Memorial Day 2022 in Belfast, a time to come together to honour our fallen officers from across the four nations. The service on Sunday 25th September will start at 1400hrs but please be in your seat by 1330hrs. There is no Saturday evening Civic Reception this year. The Civic Reception will be held after the service which proved to be a successful format last year when NPMD 2021 took place at Lincoln Cathedral with a reduced attendance due to Covid restrictions. This year we are very pleased to be able to invite everyone to attend in person and pay their respects.

Many of you have already registered to attend and we look forward to seeing you in Belfast and kindly ask that you circulate details of NPMD 2022 to family, friends and colleagues.

### **Discounted Hotels and Travel**

We have arranged for some excellent discounts at hotels but you do need to book in the next few weeks to ensure that rooms are available at the discounted rate as it is a very busy weekend in Belfast. We have also arranged a discount with Stena ferries. This is only for those attending the memorial service and therefore we cannot display the information on our website which is open to everyone. The routes for which the 20% discount applies are: Liverpool – Belfast, Cairnryan – Belfast, Holyhead – Dublin and Fishguard – Rosslare. Obviously the earlier you book the cheaper the base fare to which the 20% discount will be applied. ### **Registration**

A visit to the Royal Ulster Constabulary George Cross Foundation (RUCGC) Memorial Garden can also be booked during the registration process. If you omitted to do that when you made the original booking you can still go back into EventBrite using the email address with which you made the original booking and make any changes necessary. You do need to ensure that you download the amended ticket and have this available on your smart phone or as a paper copy when you come to the venue or to access the bus taking visitors to the RUCGC Memorial Garden. The departure point for the buses will be notified to those who book tickets to the Garden closer to the day itself.
