CROWN BADGE FOR THE POLICE REMEMBRANCE TRUST

To mark the merger of National Police Memorial Day with The Police Roll of Honour Trust

The charity's new crown badge as 'The Police Remembrance Trust' was designed and granted by The Lord Lyon who is responsible for the granting of new arms to persons or organisations, and for confirming proven pedigrees and claims to existing arms.

The King's royal cypher sits in the middle of the national symbols for each country in the United Kingdom: the rose for England, the leek for Wales, the thistle for Scotland and the shamrock for Northern Ireland. Books depicting the Police Roll of Honour sit alongside each of the four national symbols.

As well as maintaining National Police Memorial Day, other priorities for the new Police Remembrance Trust is to build on the efforts already in progress to establish a Welsh Police Memorial, and to continue working in partnership with the new UK Digital Police Memorial.

This marks a new era for UK police memorial charities and the Police Remembrance Trust firmly believes that recognising bravery, commitment, integrity, dedication and sacrifice is a great reflection of the vast majority of those involved in policing today. Affirming their role and telling their stories can be part of the solution to the issues they and the service currently face.
